As the birthplace of BC, our goal includes heightening the awareness of BC's heritage through our music, dance, arts etc., and providing exposure for local artists.

Performances to be awarded include our open-air concert stage, parade entry and/or float, and easy listening.

Please provide us with your promotional kit and any tapes or CDs. We may request an audition of your group.

**Equipment provided:** A complete sound system is available with sound engineer for the outdoor main stage (approx. 20' x 16'). Performers **MUST** provide any **special equipment requirements**.

**Compensation:** Performers are paid Honorariums which are funded primarily by a community grant and fundraising efforts of the Fort Langley BIA. This is a free community event – there is no admission fee charged to the public.

- Bio/professional resume of your group
- Promotional photographs
- Two reviews (optional)
- A representative sample of your work
- Musicians: CD or webclip
- Dance groups: one VHS videotape or webclip
